## Congratulations & Condolences!

"Congratulations & condolences" is what Jimmy always says to a new couple – congratulations on your engagement, and condolences, because now you have to plan the wedding.

It's not always easy. But we're going to make sure that the flowers, decor, and visual styling of your wedding match your vision with a minimum of stress for you. Take a deep breath and relax; we're sweating the details every day so you don't have to.



# Who We Are

We're called greenSinner because we're not green saints. We strive to be as local and sustainable as possible in our business practices, but we don't put limitations on our clients to conform to rigorous environmental standards. We grow roughly 16,000 flowers every year on our Lawrenceville micro-farm, and source many of the rest from other local farmers. But if there is a particular flower that you want to see on your special day, we will source it commercially if need be.

# Our Process

Typically you'll get in touch with us over the phone or through our website to tell us you're getting married and you're interested in working with us. We'll have a quick conversation to make sure your wedding date and location works with our schedule and gather some basic details from you.

The next step depends on what you're looking for from us. For full-service clients, we will build you a rough proposal. If you are happy with the direction we are heading, we'll schedule a time to sit down with you (and your fiancé, mom, best friend, or whoever you'd like to be involved) to develop a shared vision of what your wedding looks like. For smaller orders (pick-ups, drop-offs, just personal flowers, etc.) we can almost always provide a quote via email.

We are transparent about pricing; our quotes always contain line-item pricing and a summary of all of the fees associated with delivery, setup, teardown, etc. There will never be hidden charges or surprise fees later in the process.

# Budget Guidelines

Here are some general guidelines for our pricing:

- We do have a minimum of \$10,000 for each of our weddings that are during June - November. Weddings that place December - May have a \$6,000 minimum. While we understand that this budget may not work for everyone, we like to offer another option that may work. Our Green Saints Collection includes bridal bouquet, other bouquets, boutonnieres, corsages, and centerpieces as a customer pickup from our studio. There is no minimum for those services.

- A bridal bouquet typically costs an average of \$300 and a minimum of \$230. Bridesmaid's bouquets typically cost an average of \$150 and a minimum of \$100.

- A boutonnière or pin corsage typically costs \$35, a wrist corsage \$45, a floral crown \$110.

- A basic floral centerpiece for an 8- to 10-person round table typically starts at \$225. Smaller centerpieces can be less expensive. Larger, elevated, or more elaborate centerpieces will be more expensive. Tablescape, garlands, or arrangements of numerous smaller items are typically more expensive overall because they involve additional labor to set up and take down.

- In addition to typical floral items such as these, we also offer many additional décor options, such as chuppahs and arches, installations, and anything you can dream up, we can make happen.

- Your formal quote will include delivery, on-site labor for setup and teardown, and sales tax.
